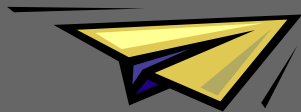


## RWTO/OERO

## Retirement Matters !

In 1956, a small group of retired women teachers got together for the purpose of trying to persuade the government to raise the level of pensions for retired women teachers to the same level as their male colleagues. In the following years, many new groups were formed and joined in the crusade to present a stronger case to the government.

In 1967, success was achieved when the government agreed that the minimum pension would be raised to \$1200.00 per year.

We have come a long way since then!

This group continues to exist because there is still a need for an organization that cares for the interests and well-being of retired women teachers.

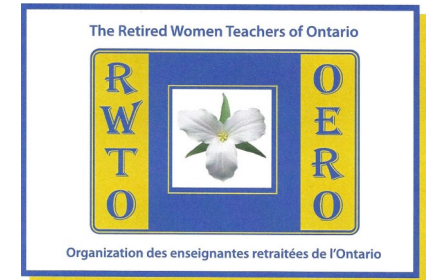

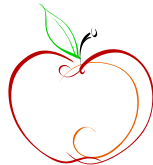
