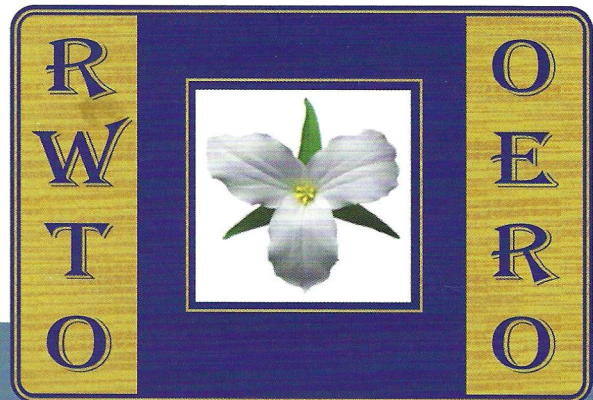

## **About RWTO/OERO**

We are retired women teachers who have joined together to form a professional organization called the Retired Women Teachers of Ontario/ organisation des enseignantes retraitées de l'Ontario.

Nous sommes des femmes retraitées qui se sont regroupées pour former une organisation professionnelle.

The purpose of our group is to provide fellowship, friendship, communication and support to retired women teachers. There are about 5200 members organized into 50 local Branches throughout the province.

Our organization was formed in April 1956 by a small group of retired women teachers in Toronto. In 1967, they became successful advocates of pension reform and RWTO/OERO has continued to show support for the special interests of women teachers.



## **Insurance Plans**

All members and their spouses can participate in 3 specialized plans–

Hospital and Home Care which offers different types of benefits including convalescent, home nursing, fracture, cataract surgery, transportation, mobility assistance, etc.

Personal Accidental Death & Dismemberment which offers family transportation, vehicle modification, repatriation benefits, etc.

Travel which offers emergency hospital medical protection, trip cancellation, extending existing coverage, etc.
