You Play a Part in Securing Your Information

Being cautious and concerned about your private information is priority #1. These suggestions may help you to be an *informed* participant since retirees are one of the largest groups targeted.



NEVER give your Social Insurance number to anyone.

Always check out charities through reliable sources.

- 1) **Telephone calls**: Don't recognize the number?- let it go to voicemail. If answered *give no personal information*. Contact the company the caller gave you. *Microsoft* will never call you about your computer.
- 2) **Phone Surveys**: Explain you don't do phone surveys. Tell them to mail it and you will complete it. *Give no personal information!*
- 3) **Sales Pressure / Free Gifts:** If it seems too good to be true—it probably is! Once you **state you aren't interested, end the call.**
- 4) *Ignore* Continuous callers or email messages with words like: 'URGENT', 'last chance', 'expires soon', 'can you help me?' even with names you know. In closing, if it feels wrong it usually is. Less talk or written words, more safety for you. A little suspicious concern is wise when protecting your privacy. Scams can and do happen—don't be a victim!
