- 3. Turn right and proceed to the roundabout.
- 4. Take the exit for Dublin Line (north) on the roundabout
- 5. The entrance to Granite Ridge Golf Club is on the right-hand side.

- 1. <u>If coming from Burlington or Milton</u>, proceed north on Tremaine Rd which proceeds over the 401.
- 2. At the round-about just past 401, take the north exit with signs posted: Granite Ridge Golf and Country Club.
