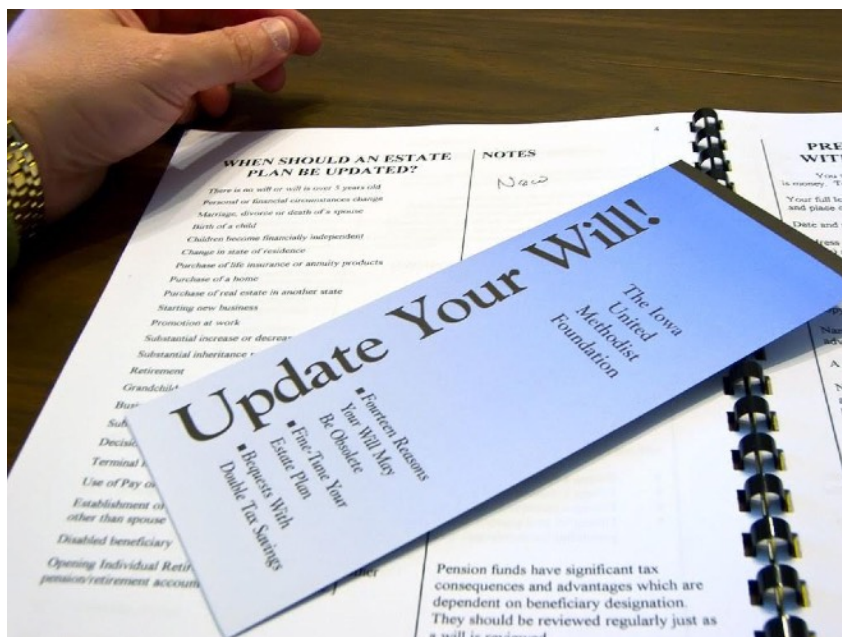
Parking: Due to the limited parking in the area, it is highly recommended that members make arrangements to carpool to the library.
