INSURANCE

I have received inquiries about how our plan co-ordinates with other insurance you may have. There is also a way our plan can top-up your other plan benefits.

Let's look at the Physiotherapy Benefit. It pays for physiotherapy treatment by a licensed professional physiotherapist following a period of confinement in hospital and when recommended by your physician. You may claim a \$200.00 maximum per policy year and receipts are required. While the CCAC will often provide you with Physiotherapy due to knee or hip replacement, it is generally found to be insufficient for your needs and you may require additional treatments. You can also Co-ordinate this benefit with another plan if you have one. For example, the RTO plan will pay 80% of the cost for physiotherapy to a combined plan maximum of \$900.00 which includes all paramedical services such as chiropractic and physiotherapy. Members who use our plan to top-up that plan or co-ordinate the coverage to have 100% of the expense covered.
