

RWTO/OERO Insurance Plans

Our Insurance Program is often cited as one of the most significant benefits of membership in RWTO/OERO. As an RWTO member in good standing, you and your spouse are eligible. Home and Health Care Plan supplements your provincial health care plan. It is different from your extended health care insurance as it offers post-hospital home care following an illness or accident.

Apply within one year of the date of your retirement to be guaranteed enrollment in the plan without completing a medical questionnaire. Your spouse must complete a medical questionnaire regardless of your retirement date.

Personal Accidental Death and Dismemberment Plan provides 24-hour coverage, anywhere in the world for accidents causing loss or loss of limb, paralysis or accidental death.
